- International projects – focused on street work, theater, music, group volunteering projects
- Office & media tasks – writing and sending emails, creating engaging content for our social media (Instagram, Facebook)
- Any other spontaneous ideas that come to your or our minds



WHAT WILL BE YOUR TASKS:

- We have two places for our activities - CAO - Centrum of Community activities and Centrum of Integration for foreigners. Both are in the city center. There you can conduct your own language clubs, board games, workshops, drawing clubs and much more.
- Also we have project since June 1, 2026 - Ukrainian Saturday School where you can help as well;
- We are interested in supporting young people and sustainable way of life.

LOCATION ACCOMMODATION

Jelenia Góra –
in Polish, the name means
"The Mountain of the Deer."

The town is surrounded by the Jizera Mountains and Jizera Foothills to the west, the Kaczawskie Mountains to the north, the Rudawy Janowickie Mountains to the east, and the Karkonosze Mountains to the south.

So, if you love mountains, this is the perfect place for you!

- the flat is in a calm area, next to a river
- just a 15-minute walk from the city center
- You will live with another volunteer in a 2-rooms flat or 3 roomed flat
- the flat is fully equipped – including a washing machine, stove, and even a real cat (the one from the photo on the previous page)



WHAT YOU GET FROM THE PROGRAM



- Accommodation & Living – housing, meals, and pocket money
- Travel Reimbursement – coverage of travel costs to and from the project location (Jelenia góra)
- Health Insurance – full insurance coverage throughout the volunteering period
- Language Support in learning polish
- Training & Skill Development – on-arrival and mid-term training sessions
- Recognition & Certification –
Youthpass Certificate

- Intercultural exchange - meet people from different countries and cultures

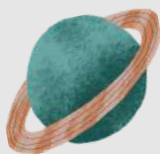

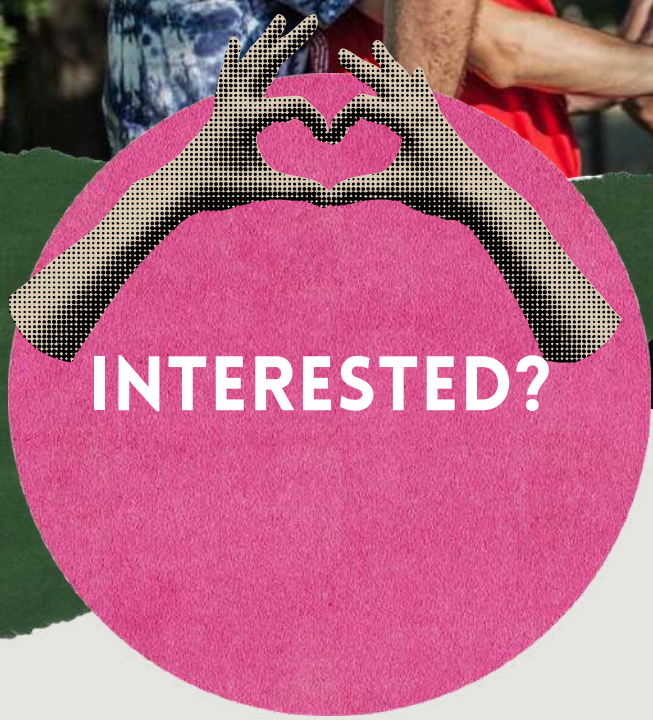
